Beachfront Original

*First new beachfront residential
in a decade at 3550 South Ocean*

Real estate development firm DDG recently completed 3550 South Ocean, the first new beachfront residential development in Palm Beach in a decade, and closings are now underway. Designed by GarciaStromberg | GS4studios, Kobi Karp Architecture and Champalimaud Design, the seven-story building, at 3550 S. Ocean Blvd., has a “sawtooth” form, allowing each of the 30 two- and three-bedroom units, which range from 2,600 to over 3,400 square feet, to have natural light and ocean views. The units at 3550 South Ocean have a Palm Beach aesthetic and feature private elevator foyers, chef-caliber kitchens, top-of-the-line appliances and fixtures, floor-to-ceiling windows and private balconies. There are five penthouses with private rooftop terraces, complete with custom spas and outdoor kitchens. Building amenities include private beach access, a beachfront pool, fitness studio and 24/7 concierge. Residents receive exclusive benefits at the nearby Eau Palm Beach Resort & Spa.
